

Link your Canvas™ and WebAssign courses and activities to provide access to WebAssign content from your Canvas course.

With this integration:

- You and your students access your WebAssign courses from Canvas.
- Your students' grades for either the WebAssign course or activities can be synced to Canvas.

Create a New Canvas-Integrated WebAssign Course

If you have not created the WebAssign course you want to integrate with Canvas, create it from Canvas.

Note

You can also create a new course by copying your old course, or another instructor's course if you have the class key. For more information, see help.cengage.com/webassign/instructor_guide/common/copy-course-options-canvas.htm.

- 1 Open your Canvas course.
- 2 Add the Cengage app to your course navigation if it is not already listed.

The app is copied when you copy a Canvas course.

- a From the course navigation, click **Settings > Navigation**.
 - b Drag the Cengage app to the course navigation.
 - c Click **Save**.
- 3 From the course navigation, click **Cengage**.
 - 4 If prompted, sign in to your Cengage account.
 - 5 Click **Add Homework Platform**.
 - 6 Select the textbook or product you want to use from the available course content.
 - 7 Select **Create a new WebAssign course**.
 - 8 Complete the details for your WebAssign course.
 - 9 Click **Continue**.
 - 10 Click the link to your WebAssign course.

Add Links in Canvas to WebAssign Activities and Resources

After setting up your WebAssign course, create links from Canvas to activities or other content in WebAssign. Linked graded activities are included in the Canvas gradebook unless you choose to exclude them.

Note

Category scores and overall course scores can not be synced to Canvas.

Before adding links to WebAssign activities, make sure your WebAssign course is set up the way you want it.

- Add and organize the assigned activities and course materials for your WebAssign course.
- Configure assignment settings such as grading, attempts, feedback, time limits, due dates, point values, and grade categories.

- 1 Open your Canvas course.
- 2 From the course navigation, click **Cengage**.
- 3 Select your linked WebAssign course from the list of content sources.
- 4 Select activities to include in your course.

If your school uses a Canvas Partner integration, due and available dates set in your WebAssign course are synced to Canvas.

- 5 Configure grade syncing with Canvas.

Note

Depending on your course and Canvas configuration, some of the following options might not be available.

| To do this | Do this |
|---|--|
| Add a graded activity to the Canvas gradebook | Select Add to Gradebook for the activity. |
| Exclude a graded activity from the Canvas gradebook | Clear Add to Gradebook for the activity. |
| Add a graded activity to the Canvas gradebook without adding the activity link | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Select Add to Gradebook. b. Clear Add to Course. |

- 6 Click **Continue**.

The selected links are added to the module. If needed, you can reorganize the links in Canvas.

Troubleshooting

WebAssign Course is not in Your LMS

After selecting **Link to an existing course or section** in your LMS, your WebAssign course does not display as an option.

Cause

Your WebAssign course already has students enrolled.

Students must be enrolled through the LMS in order for their grades to be synced. You cannot link a WebAssign course that already has students enrolled.

Resolution

- 1 Either drop all students from your course, or create a new WebAssign course by copying the existing course.
- 2 Instruct your students to enroll in the course through the LMS.
